The 53rd National Cage Bird Show

The 53rd National Cage Bird Show is coming to Manchester, NH for the first time since 1994! The Show is hosted by the Birds of A Feather Avicultural Society (Manchester, NH) and will be held at the "The Center of New Hampshire" in Manchester, NH on November 15-17, 2001. The Public is Welcome to view judging on Friday 11/16 - 8 AM to 6 PM. All birds are on exhibit Saturday 11/17 -10 AM to 6 PM. Available both days are vendors, raffles, all the major National Clubs, along with bird sales and lots more. Bird Sales and Vendors open at 10 AM. More recent shows were held in Puerto Rico and Buffalo, NY. This show has been 2 years in the planning and is considered to be the "show of shows". Many national and international judges and exhibitors make the trip each year to the National Cage Bird Show.

A huge contingent of exhibitors from around the globe brings their best birds for judging. There will quite possibly be over 3,000 birds on exhibit. A large portion of birds to be shown is Canaries and Finches, however, there are also Love Birds, Cockatiels, Parrots and more. For clarification, these birds are not caught in the wild, most are bred carefully and specifically to produce the desired result of the "perfect National Cage Bird Show bird". There are many different classifications and very detailed specifications for each Division. The two most prestigious awards for which bird breeders and exhibitors vie are the Kellogg and Scannell Trophies. Generously donated each year by Scott Pet Products these trophies have contributed greatly to making the National Cage Bird Show the outstanding gathering of bird exhibitors for all over the United States and beyond.
